Webinar on India and Southeast Asia: Constructing a Responsible and Responsive Partnership in the Indo-Pacific

On November 21,2020, Symbiosis School of International Studies(SSIS), Pune held a webinar on the theme India and Southeast Asia: Constructing a Responsible and Responsive Partnership in the Indo-Pacific.
